Bible Links:

Luk 1:26 In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, **God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth**, a village in Galilee,

Luke 1:27 to a virgin named Mary. She was engaged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of King David.

Luk 1:28 Gabriel appeared to her and said, "Greetings, favored woman! The Lord is with you!"

Luk 1:29 Confused and disturbed, Mary tried to think what the angel could mean.

Luk 1:30 "Don't be afraid, Mary," the angel told her, "for you have found favor with God!"

Luk 1:31 **You will conceive and give birth to a son**, and you will name him Jesus.

Luk 1:32 He will be very great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his ancestor David.

Luk 1:33 And he will reign over Israel forever; his Kingdom will never end!"

Luk 1:34 Mary asked the angel, "But how can this happen? I am a virgin."

Luk 1:35 The angel replied, "**The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you**. So the baby to be born will be holy, and he will be called the Son of God.

Luk 1:36 What's more, your relative Elizabeth has become pregnant in her old age! People used to say she was barren, but she has conceived a son and is now in her sixth month.

Luk 1:37 For the word of God will never fail."

Luk 1:38 Mary responded, "I am the Lord's servant. May everything you have said about me come true." And then the angel left her.

Mary's response to the angel Gabriel's offer demonstrates her complete acceptance and surrender to God's will. She made a firm decision without hesitation.

After accepting the offer, Gabriel left. Guess what happened? The Holy Spirit immediately took control of the divine will to carry out a special operation in Mary's life. Hallelujah!

Like Mary, God's plan for us from the moment we were conceived in our mother's womb is to be fruitful, multiply, fill the earth, and subdue it, and to have dominion. But in our battles with Satan, these blessings have been taken from us.

Jesus came to restore these blessings. Hallelujah!

He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. **For this purpose, the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.** 1 John 3:8

Prayer Guides.

1. Power of the Highest, overshadow me now and empower me to fulfill the purpose for which I was born, in the name of Jesus Christ.
2. Power of the Highest, overshadow me now and strengthen my ability to surrender to the divine will for my life, in the name of Jesus Christ.
3. Power of the Highest, overshadow me now and perfect the restoration of my dominion and glory in the name of Jesus Christ.
4. Power of the Highest, overshadow me now and perfect the restoration of my life and destiny in the name of Jesus Christ.
5. Power of the Highest, overshadow me now and empower me to take back my life in Jesus' name.

But some of us, like Mary, initially agreed with God and later changed our minds. We doubted. We grew impatient. We gave in to Satan's deception and lost touch with the divine.

Abraham also agreed with God to have Isaac, but he gave in to Sarah's suggestion and paid a high price for it. Some of us are like Abraham; we didn't wait. We decided to go into error. May the Lord have mercy today.

Abraham wanted to have his cake and eat it too, keeping Ishmael and Isaac together. God said no. (Genesis 21:12) Ishmael had to go for Isaac to thrive.

If you want to take back your life, the Ishmael you received by mistake must be addressed in accordance with divine instruction.

Prayer Guides:

1. Power of the Highest, arise now and destroy every evil device the enemy has used to lead me into error, in the name of Jesus Christ.

Isa 51:1 "Listen to me, all who hope for deliverance—**all who seek the LORD!** Consider the rock from which you were cut, the quarry from which you were mined.

Isa 51:2 Yes, think about Abraham, your ancestor, and Sarah, who gave birth to your nation. Abraham was only one man when I called him. But when I blessed him, he became a great nation."

Isa 51:3 The LORD will comfort Israel (Zion) again and have pity on her ruins. Her desert will blossom like Eden, her barren wilderness like the garden of the LORD. Joy and gladness will be found there. Songs of thanksgiving will fill the air. NLT.

The divine Spirit says, "Think about Abraham, the father of all the faithful, of everyone who follows after righteousness, and Sarah, the mother of the faithful. How He called Abraham alone, blessed him, and multiplied him."

By the word of the Lord, which is 'Think about Abraham,' one is encouraged to seriously consider connecting with divine grace, as seen in how God called him alone and transformed him into a nation.

Remember the word of Gabriel to Mary, "For with God nothing will be impossible." – Luke 1:37

Isaiah 51:1 The Lord says, "Listen to me, all who hope for deliverance—**all who seek the LORD!**"

The Lord is speaking to you this morning, urging you to listen to His word and observe His actions. He is asking you to connect with His grace so that you can take back your life. Hallelujah!

You have taken back your life when the Lord restores your Destiny Zion.

You have taken back your life when the Lord transforms your desert into a garden like Eden.

You have taken back your life when your barren wilderness is turned into a garden like the Lord's.

You have taken back your life when joy and happiness are restored to you.

You have taken back your life when the sound of singing and giving thanks fills your mouth.

Prayer Guides:

1. Father God, arise now by the Holy Spirit and restore my Destiny Zion again in the name of Jesus Christ.

2. Father God, arise now by the Holy Spirit and turn my desert into a garden like Eden in Jesus' name.
3. Father God, arise now by the Holy Spirit and transform my barren wilderness into a garden like the Lord's, in the name of Jesus Christ.
4. Father God, arise now by the Holy Spirit and restore joy and happiness to my life in Jesus' name.
5. Father God, by Your Spirit, fill my mouth with singing and gratitude in the name of Jesus Christ.
