What is exaltation?

Exaltation is the state of being exalted. It means to lift up.

Exaltation is an elevation.

To exalt is to raise in **power**, position, character, **status**, or a similar category.

It is to promote.

Bible links:

Job 22:29 When they cast you down, and you say, 'Exaltation will come!' Then He will save the humble person. NKJV.

Job 22:30 He will *even* deliver one who is not innocent; Yes, he will be delivered by the purity of your hands." NKJV.

Job 22:29 "When you are cast down *and* humbled, you will speak with confidence, and the humble person He will lift up *and* save.

Job 22:30 "He will even rescue the one [*for whom you intercede*] who is not innocent; And he will be rescued through the cleanness of your hands." [Job 42:7-8] AMP.

2Co 4:8 We are pressured in every way [*hedged in*], but not crushed; perplexed [*unsure of finding a way out*], but not driven to despair;

2Co 4:9 hunted down *and* persecuted, but not deserted [*to stand alone*]; struck down, but never destroyed; AMP.

2Co 4:8 We are pressed on every side by troubles, but we are not crushed. We are perplexed, but not driven to despair.

2Co 4:9 We are hunted down, but never abandoned by God. We get knocked down, but we are not destroyed. NLT

Luk 14:11 For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, **and he who humbles himself will be exalted.**" NKJV.

Psa 147:5 Great is our Lord, and mighty in power; His understanding is infinite.

Psa 147:6 **The LORD lifts up the humble;** He casts the wicked down to the ground.

Psa 75:4 "I said to the boastful, 'Do not deal boastfully,' And to the wicked, 'Do not lift up the horn.

Psa 75:5 Do not lift up your horn on high; Do *not* speak with a stiff neck.' "

Psa 75:6 **For exaltation comes neither from the east nor from the west nor from the south.**

Psa 75:7 **But God is the Judge: He puts down one, and exalts another.** NKJV

Psa 37:34 Wait for *and expect the LORD* and keep His way, and He will exalt you to inherit the land; [*In the end*] when the wicked are cut off, you will see it. AMP

1Pe 5:6 Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God [*set aside self-righteous pride*], so that He may exalt you [*to a place of honor in His service*] at the appropriate time, AMP

What are the signs that exaltation has come?

1. **Your patience will be severely tested.** - Job 40:1 Then the LORD said to Job, Job 40:2 “Do you still want to argue with the Almighty? You are God’s critic, but do you have the answers?”
2. **Insulting and ridiculing words may be constantly hurled at you.** - 1Sa 1:6 So Peninnah would taunt Hannah and make fun of her because the LORD had kept her from having children. NLT.
3. **Your loyalty to the Lord may be openly misjudged and ridiculed by friends and others.** - Job 42:7 After the LORD had finished speaking to Job, he said to Eliphaz the Temanite: “I am angry with you and your two friends, for you have not spoken accurately about me, as my servant Job has.
4. **There may be a divine visitation that will guide you toward your exaltation.** – Jos 1:6 “Be strong and courageous, for you are the one who will lead these people to possess all the land I swore to their ancestors I would give them.
Jos 1:7 Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the instructions Moses gave you. Do not deviate from them, turning either to the right or to the left. Then you will be successful in everything you do.
Jos 1:8 Study this Book of Instruction continually. Meditate on it day and night so you will be sure to obey everything written in it. Only then will you prosper and succeed in all you do.
5. **Your desire to pray may suddenly become strong.** – 1Sa 1:9 Once after a sacrificial meal at Shiloh, **Hannah got up and went to pray.** Eli the priest was sitting at his customary place beside the entrance of the Tabernacle.
6. **Your desire to help others or to take an interest in their well-being may suddenly grow.** - Gen 40:5 While they were in prison, Pharaoh’s cup-bearer and baker each had a dream one night, and each dream had its own meaning.
Gen 40:6 When Joseph saw them the next morning, he noticed that they both looked upset.
Gen 40:7 “Why do you look so worried today?” he asked them.
Gen 40:8 And they replied, “We both had dreams last night, but no one can tell us what they mean.”
“Interpreting dreams is God’s business,” Joseph replied. “Go ahead and tell me your dreams.”
7. **You may lay aside your garment of pride and put on a new garment of humility.** - 1Sa 1:14 “Must you come here drunk?” he demanded. “Throw away your wine!”
1Sa 1:15 “Oh no, sir!” she replied. “I haven’t been drinking wine or anything stronger. But I am very discouraged, and I was pouring out my heart to the LORD.

6. I declare by the Spirit of the Lord that, after the order of Mordecai, I am now promoted to relevance, and the Lord will sustain me there in the name of Jesus Christ.
7. I declare, by the Spirit of the Lord, that today I am elevated from barrenness to fruitfulness, from lack to abundance, from illness to wholeness, from bondage to liberty, from weakness to strength, and from captivity to freedom, in the name of Jesus Christ.
